2015 LISTAHANAN RESULTS

Listahan, also known as the National Household Targeting System for Poverty Reduction (NHTS-PR) was established by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) to target who and where the poor are. The comprehensive database serves as a basis for selecting beneficiaries for social protection programs and services in the country. Results from the second assessment conducted in 2015 identified **165,689 poor households** among the **883,831 assessed households** in Region 1.



Of the 165,689 targeted poor households

- 25.91%** have outer walls made with strong materials
- 60.56%** have roofing made with strong materials
- 19.89% or 32,963** do not have access to electricity
- 14.31% or 23,712** do not have access to a safe water source
- 33.81% or 56,015** do not have sanitary toilet facility



Of the 993,156 individuals who constitute the 165,689 poor households

- 48% or 476,716 FEMALE**
- 52% or 516,440 MALE**
- 54.72% or 543,414 CHILDREN**
- 4.44% or 44,078 SENIOR CITIZEN**

1.41% or 14,036 HAVE THE FOLLOWING DISABILITIES:

- Hearing & visual impairment
- Mentally challenged
- Multiple disabilities
- Speech defect
- Orthopedic

5.42% or 8,982 poor households belong to an Indigenous Peoples Groups.

Highest magnitude of IPs are found in the province of: La Union

11.55% OR 61,320 INDIVIDUALS are engaged in agricultural activities as farmers, forestry workers or fishermen.

53.43% of the 993,156 poor individuals are part of the labor force and a great majority of them are found in rural areas

265,775 do not have any reported occupation
